Invasive Pear Trees

Jennifer Behnken, Urban and Community Forestry Coordinator, SIUC Department of Forestry, and Karla Gage, representing the Riverto-River Cooperative Weed Management Area body, shared extensive information about Callery pear (AKA Bradford pear) trees as an *invasive* species. Who knew?

This species is a potentially problematic tree for residents and land managers alike. Because of cross-pollination, high maintenance pruning, short tree life, and proneness to splitting, the tree can become a strain on land management budgets.

Behnken and Gage announced an upcoming (April 26) event to highlight issues with this species, educate the public, and show a positive solution by promoting native species. The event will be conducted at Attucks Park and Piles Fork Preserve, 9 a.m. to 12 noon. Drinks and lunch will be provided. Alternative native species will be planted in a community demonstration area at that site. This is a pilot project for Illinois, modeled on a similar effort in Missouri.

The ornamental pear species is an early-blooming spring tree with notable eye appeal. Also, it is a profitable product for nurseries. As a result, homeowners use it often, perhaps without knowing the added cost for successful maintenance as well as the cost of more frequent replacement.

Such native species as hawthorne, red bud, dogwood, service berry, and black gum are effective alternatives, they noted.
