Not Just India ...

The World Health Organization certified on 27 March its 11-country Southeast Asia region has eradicated polio. This was a long-awaited declaration given that five years ago India represented nearly half of all polio cases worldwide.

The region includes Bangladesh, Bhutan, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, India, Indonesia, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Timor-Leste. Its more than 1.8 billion people represent over 25 percent of the world's population. The region's last wild polio case was reported in West Bengal, India, on 13 January 2011.

Southeast Asia joins WHO's Region of the Americas (1994), Western Pacific Region (2000), and European Region (2002) in eradicating polio, marking another major step toward a polio-free world by 2018.
