TRF: Global Grants

To round out Foundation Month, Deputy Governor-Foundation / DGN **Dave Matthews** shared a closer look at the Global Grants program of The Rotary Foundation.

These grants offer clubs and districts "opportunities to participate in high-impact activities, such as international humanitarian projects, vocational training teams, and scholarships that have sustainable, measurable outcomes in one or more of Rotary's six areas of focus."

The grants must have a minimum total budget of \$30,000, including the World Fund award, which is based on a 100 percent match of District Designated Fund (DDF) allocation or a 50 percent match of cash contributions from sponsors. All global grants must be sponsored by two clubs or districts: a host sponsor in the country where the activity takes place and an international partner outside that country.

Matthews also acknowledged members who have recently served or are currently serving on district-level Foundation committees: PDG Jack Langowski, George Waring, Fred Betz, and Steve Battiste.
