Rotary News

The June issue of the District newsletter included the DG's message, a polio update, selection of the Club of the Month, info on Peace Fellowship applications, and a feature on 100 Men Who Cook. Old National Bank VP **Shane Carsrud** was pictured presenting a symbolic check for \$62,799 to DG **Tom Ripperda**. The issue was published 1 July.

PDG Tom mentioned the **100 Men Who Cook** event in his message, noting "it was a challenge [that] no one club could have done" and citing it as an example of fellowship as well as a worthy charitable activity.

Polio. A total of 55 new cases of polio has been reported through 12 June, including new cases in the Horn of Africa, which had been polio-free in 2012. New cases this year: Afghanistan, 12; Nigeria, 25; Pakistan, 14; Horn of Africa, 14.

Red Bud. The RC -Red Bud was named "Club of the Month" for a project providing wheelchair access for a local special needs youth, age 9.

Peace Fellows. The Rotary Peace Fellowship is an educational program leading to a Master's degree or a Professional Development Certificate, both for the purpose of supportin Rotary's mission to advance world understanding, peace, and goodwill.
