The Women s Center

Executive Director **Cathy McClanahan** and Development Specialist **Sandy Ursini** provided information about the Women's Center and its programs. McClanahan has served as Executive Director since 2008 and involved with TWC beginning in 1991.

The primary purposes of TWC are to end violence; assist ANY survivor; provide public education, professional training, and prevention; act on behalf of survivors; and assure confidentiality.

The primary programs focus on domestic violence and sexual assault. *Domestic violence* is a learned behavior, not an illness or driven by alcohol, anger, stress, or genetics. Women are the victims in 95% of domestic violence cases. Domestic violence is the leading cause of injury in women, ages 15-44, in the USA. *Sexual assault*: According to the National Center on Victims of Crime, nearly 57,000 assaults occur each month.

Regarding children, domestic violence includes physical violence (intentional and unintentional) and psychological violence, especially witnessing violence.

TWC operates in seven Southern Illinois counties, but primarily in Jackson, Williamson, and Franklin. It operates three transitional homes and one 40-bed shelter.

Ursini mentioned several fund-raising activities: coupons for shared proceeds at Lone Star, July 9-11; the popular Little Black Dress party, Sept. 13 at Rent One Park; and purchase of commemorative bricks for the anniversary garden being developed.
