Passport to Rotary

Misha Garafalo, president of the Rotary Club of Shorewood, Illinois, a former Rotary Youth Exchange student to Sweden, and the only African-American club president in Will County, initiated a unique "passport" for her club members to encourage them to "Engage Rotary" this year.

At her installation ceremony, each member received a "Passport To Rotary." The "visa" on the inside had to be signed by her and the member as an understanding of their commitment to care. Subsequent stamps will be provided to help each member engage Rotary through specific activities and projects within the club, community, district, and beyond.

As a former Rotary Youth Exchange student to Sweden more than a quarter century ago, her fondest possession is her passport filled with sought-after stamps from countries she visited. Every now and again, she reports, "I would come across the passport, flip through the pages, and reminisce about the sights, smells, and sounds which stirred my global awareness, curiosity, and perspective."

At the end of her term, she plans to personally award each Rotarian who has filled the passport with service and memories of how the Rotarian has changed lives.

Simpson and her family hosted Yann Henri for eleven months. His English wis very good, she noted, but he had some issues with managing the many (official) papers needed for the extended visit. During that time, he turned 17 years old; he was speechless about the birthday celebration he received.

Since then, Yann has communicated often, including Facebook, Skype, and exchange of pictures. Alisa also met him in Europe several times, during both vacation and business trips. She enjoyed many bonding experiences and met his family and friends. This included an exchange student, Clemens, who was at Anna-Jonesboro at the same time Yann was in Carbondale.

She emphasized that the exchange experience has a long-lasting impact on both the student and the host family or families.
