International Convention

The 2014 International Convention is underway in Sydney, Australia. This year's convention highlights Rotary's progress in eradicating polio, providing clean water, improving sanitation, building peace, fighting poverty, and empowering youth.

Jack Sim, founder of the World Toilet Organization and the World Toilet College, will share his passion for improved sanitation. Sim participated in last year's World Water Summit and is committed to getting people talking about a subject often considered taboo.

Other keynote speakers include **Gemma Sisia**, founder of the School of St. Jude in Tanzania, sharing her ideas for fighting poverty through education; and Brett Lee, Australian cricket star and founder of Mewsic, a foundation supporting music centers for disadvantaged children in India.

Former Paralympian and polio survivor **Ade Adepitan** is will inspire convention goers with his story. Dr. Bruce **Aylward**, assistant director-general for Polio, Emergencies, and Country Collaboration (World Health Organization), will provide an update on the status of the effort to end polio worldwide.
