A Few Convention Highlights

At the Rotary International convention in Sydney, Australia, Nigerian business leader and philanthropist **Sir Emeka Offor** announced a \$1 million gift to The Rotary Foundation for polio eradication efforts.

Prime Minister Tony Abbott of Australia also announced his government will commit \$100 million over five years to help eradicate polio.

Rotary Scholar **Kelsi Lopatecki Cox**, a prime example of what can happen when we nurture young people, championed innovative technology and education as a way to address poverty and under-development in rural communities. She is program coordinator for the Digital Learning Room, a project that brings technology to schools in the South Pacific.

K.R. "Ravi" Ravindran, a member of the Rotary Club of Colombo, Western Province, Sri Lanka, was elected the 2015-16 RI president, telling the audience he accepts "this life-time opportunity with great humility."

Ramkumar Raju, Rotaract representative for District 3230 in India and another speaker in the fourth plenary session, was instrumental in planning the Presidential New Generations Conference in Chennai in October (2013), which attracted nearly 3,000 attendees and set a Guinness World Record for the world's largest high-five.
