Profile: RI Pres. Huang

RI's 2014-2015 President, Gary C. K. Huang, was interviewed for the March edition of The Rotarian. A Rotarian since 1976, Huang is a member of the Rotary Club of Taipei, Taiwan, and has served Rotary as vice president, director, trustee of the Rotary Foundation, group discussion leader for the International Assembly, and task force coordinator. He is the first Chinese selected to serve as RI president.

During his one-year term of office as of 1 July, Huang seeks to increase total membership by 50,000, with particular emphasis on recruiting Rotary alumni - e.g., former Rotaractors and Group Study Exchange members – as well as spouses and family members of Rotarians.

Huang selected the annual theme of *Light Up Rotary* to "show Rotary to the public" because Rotary "has been doing so many good things in so many communities all over the world."

Through his service with Rotary International, he has earned the RI Service Above Self Award, a Presidential Citation, and The Rotary Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and the Distinguished Service Award.

Celebration of Rotary

For the 25 February weekly meeting, club members joined in various in-meeting activities to recognize the 109th anniversary of the founding of Rotary International.

Dan Becque shared several video presentations about RI and its projects, promoting awareness of Rotary and membership. Members commented that we should see these brief videos more frequently.

While displaying the **Governor's Trophy** and the rarely viewed club **charter** from 1988, Terry Mathias invited members to voice perspectives on being a Rotarian. In turn, **eight members** each selected a folded card from the front table and responded to the written question. Responses highlighted member insights about being a Rotarian, good characteristics of a Rotary club, important values of the international organization, and similar prompts.

On Wednesday evening (26 Feb.), members of four clubs - Carbondale, Carterville, Jackson-Williamson County Sunset, and Carbondale-Breakfast - met at The Grotto (Newell House) for a celebration social. Good food, great fellowship!

Prior to these events, three clubs and the district cooperated in funding promotional announcements on WSIU Radio, the local NPR affiliate, over a ten-day period preceding the 23 February anniversary date.
