Business Meeting

Minutes. February, not available.

Treasury. Year to Date: Income-\$27,774; Expenses-\$23,597. Balances: Checking-\$10,987; Accts. Rcvbl. (55); Liabilities-\$3,000 (CCHS); Equity-\$7,932. Reminder: \$700 needed to complete CCHS scholarships for this year.

Prospective Members: Two names announced for sevenday comment period: Bob Fox, Segun Ojewuyi.

CCHS Scholarship Program Review. Youth Services Committee chair Tessie Ojewuyi reported on a scheduled meeting (March 18) with Erinn Murphy (CCHS Guidance Office) to discuss a modification of the club's scholarship program. Terry Mathias outlined the recent review process, then explained a minor adjustment for flexibility in selection criteria. Beginning in 2014, scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded annually to two CCHS graduating seniors to attend *either* SIUC *or* JALC *or* another local public college. The third \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior from the CCHS Career & Technical Education (CTE) program for training, educational, and/or career starting expenses.

District Simplified Grants (DSG). Members were asked for ideas for a possible 2014-15 DSG; application date is mid-April, but preparation needs to happen now.

Use of Equity (Treasury). A question about using the equity was raised. Members noted the need to designate funding for the 25th anniversary observance. Other suggested uses: (a) aiding flood recovery at the Thrift Shop and (b) allocating matching funds for district and/or global grant possibilities.

Planning for 2014-15. PE Steve, VP Martha, VPE Fran, and other officers/directors are starting to plan for next Rotary year, including identifying committee chairs, setting club annual goals and priorities, updating the existing strategic plan, and related actions.
