#### Memorial Day

... was previously known as **Decoration Day**, and the Columbia Encyclopedia (6e) cites the origin with General John A. Logan in decorating the graves of Civil War veterans beginning in 1868. Some two dozen cities/states claim earlier dates, as early as 1861.

The *Uniform Monday Holiday Act* (Pub.L. 90–363) is the Act of Congress that amended federal holiday provisions to establish the observance of certain holidays on Mondays. The Act was signed into law on June 28, 1968, and took effect on January 1, 1971. It began observance of Washington's birthday (February 22) as the third Monday in February; Memorial Day (formerly May 30) as the last Monday in May: Labor Day as the first Monday in September: Columbus Day (formerly observed on October 12) as the second Monday in October; and Veterans Day as the fourth Monday in October (but returned to the original Nov. 11 date in 1978). The Act did not officially establish a "Presidents Day," to include joint observance of the birthdays of Washington (Feb. 22) and Lincoln (Feb. 12); yet, by 1998, a dozen states had officially named and had begun observing Presidents Day in February.

By the 20th century, Memorial Day had been extended to honor all Americans who died while in the military service. Commonly, it typically marks the (unofficial) start of the summer vacation season, with Labor Day marking the end.

#### The Hypnotic Effect

**Don Benitone** and **Deanna Giacoma** shared an interesting and informative perspective on uses of hypnosis and hypnotherapy to enhance everyday living or quality of life.

**Hypnotherapy** is a form of psychotherapy used to create unconscious change in a patient in the form of new responses, thoughts, attitudes, behaviors, or feelings. It is used to address, for example, weight loss, insomnia, anxiety, addiction, and subclinical depression, and to enhance recovery from non-psychological conditions, such as following a surgical procedure.

Brainwave entrainment (BWE), also known as brainwave synchronization, the brain's electrical response to rhythmic sensory stimulation, commonly sound waves. By listening to BWE audios, people can alter their brainwave frequencies in order to reach a desired level of consciousness. Brainwave synchronization is possible because the brain has a "frequency following" response, which occurs because the brain naturally changes its dominant EEG frequency to correspond with the dominant frequency of an external stimulus.

The brain cycles through different brainwave frequencies every day, and each frequency corresponds to a different level of consciousness. Manually tuning the brain to different frequency levels can allow easy entry into Alpha, Theta, and Delta states of consciousness associated with deep sleep, deep relaxation, meditation, creativity, and learning. The Beta wave state is everyday consciousness: normal activity, creative thinking, active thinking.
