Must-Do's ... to Get Noticed on Social Media

- 1. Create a page on Facebook for your event. Add some news before inviting friends. Keep the text short and snappy, bearing in mind that social media is designed to entertain.
- Use active photos ... show people doing thinas.

Photos of active people having fun generate the excitement you want to portray far better than check-passing photos or group shots.

- 3. Use Twitter and hashtags often. Using one or two hashtags per post makes posts visible to anyone who shares your interest.
- 4. Get all members involved in social media. Social media works as a public relations tool - likes, shares, and comments spread the original message beyond the immediate network and into the networks of friend's friends.
- 5. Spend a little money on a Facebook ad. An investment of as little as \$25 to \$50 can boost your reach significantly.
