### **Business Meeting**

**Minutes** - 8 October. Approved as presented. An update regarding costs for the RYE outbound participants was reported and will be recorded in the Minutes of the November business meeting.

**Treasury**. YTD Income: \$20.826; YTD Expense: \$13,438. Balances: Checking: \$17,975; Liabilities: \$7,000 (100 MWC-\$4,000; CCHS Scholarships-\$3,000). Equity: \$10,836.

**Recognition**. President Randy presented the Club Builder Award (bearing RI President Tanaka's signature) to Marcia Sinnott.

**Nominating Committee**. The committee reported the following slate:
