DaCdb; Rotary.org

PDG **Jack Langowski** provided a guided tour of the "District and Club Database" (DaCdb) website and the new Rotary International website (rotary.org).

Rotarians can reach DaCdb in several different ways:

- Go to www.Rotary6510.org. Click the blue-and-red rectangle (upper left) marked with "DACdb." On the next screen, enter your email address (as shown on the club roster), then your password (Your Rotary ID, eight digits, shown on the mailing address box of *The Rotarian*. Alternately, you may have chosen another password if you have already used DaCdb). The club number 26036 is optional unless you hold an office at district level.
- Go to <u>www.directory-online.com</u> or <u>www.directory-online/rotary</u> and login.
- Go to www.dacdb.com. At the upper left, click "login here" in the orange rectangle.

PDG Jack guided us through contents, Pmail, event registration, and the calendar.

For the Rotary International website ...

Go to <u>www.rotary.org.</u> Initially, you are in the public portion of the website. Click "My Rotary" at the top of the page.

- If this is your first time here, use "Register" and follow the instructions.
- If you have previously registered, sign in using the orange rectangle on the left side, partway down the screen. Your login username and password are the same as indicated above - unless you have previously changed the password.
