# **Global Public Image Initiative**

Together with global strategic branding firm Siegel+Gale, Rotary International recently announced the launch of a global public image initiative "Strengthening Rotary" to amplify RI's great story, visual identity, and digital experience.

Rotary International President Ron D. Burton reported. "In 2011, we engaged Siegel+Gale to help us clearly communicate who we are and what we do for greater understanding, relevance, and impact. Rotary has had a tremendous global impact over the past 100 years, including the decades-long charge to eradicate polio. However, much of the organization's collective contributions were not being fully recognized by the public."
