World Polio Day

On Friday, October 24, World Polio Day was celebrated with, among other activities, a Livestream event from Chicago.

It was hosted by *Time* magazine science and technology editor Jeffrey Kluger and included an update on the fight to end polio and the challenges that remain, as well as information about joining Rotary's historic campaign.

Nearly 30 years ago, Rotary International began its effort to immunize every child in the world against polio. The goal to eradicate polio is well within sight.

Among participants in the Livestream event was Minda Dentler, Director of Operations at AIG Multinational. She is also an elite athlete who competes in Ironman triathlons of 140.6 miles. She's a polio survivor and spokesperson for Rotary International.

In a pre-event interview, Dentler said, ""I'll be sharing my polio story and viewers will learn how we can end this disease forever. The event will feature a global status update on the fight to end polio, the challenges that remain, and how private citizens, corporations, and non-profits can join in the historic final push."



DG Official Visit

District Governor Lane Harvey made his official visit, introduction by AG Kelli Ballard. DG Lane emphasized that the series of club visits is the highlight of his year as DG.

He thanked the club for all we do and for our dedication. He spoke of the challenge of being a district governor, noting the achievements of prior district governors, the exceptional status of District 6510 within the Zone, and the goals set for the current Rotary year.

Harvey noted the current year's theme: "Light Up Rotary!" In turn, he issued three challenges: To "Light Up Rotary" in the club, in the community, and in the district. He reported that the challenge of attracting and retaining members is most significant for any club, noting the relevance of these actions to both the value of the club and the value of the club for the community and the district.

DG Lane previewed the excitement of the upcoming district conference (November 14-15) in Mt. Vernon, including some unique activities and opportunities.
