Foundation History

More than 3,400 people helped choose the winning title for The Rotary Foundation's history: Doing Good in the World: The Inspiring Story of The Rotary Foundation's First 100 Years.

Publication is slated for early 2016. The book will be available in English, French, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, and Spanish.

Participants voted for one of four possible book titles or submitted their own. The contest, which ended 15 June, included a lottery for one of 10 autographed copies of the book and one paid registration for two to the 2017 Rotary International Convention in Atlanta, Georgia, USA.

Asked about the title, the book's author, David Forward, said: "When Arch Klumph was Rotary's president, he announced his vision for an endowment fund to "do good in the world." No one could have imagined just how much good would come from Klumph's idea. This title perfectly reflects the Foundation's 100-year history."
