Sally Wright, chairperson of the Aquatic Committee, and **Rick Erickson**, vice-president of the Board of Commissioners, provided a status update on plans and fund-raising for the Splash Park. President Randy presented the 100 MWC allocation.

Erickson summarized the fund-raising to date, beginning with a \$2 million grant from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and an estimated \$540,000 raised or pledged to date in the capital campaign; the goal of the capital campaign is \$900,000. He emphasized that construction of the facility is not being funded by a tax referendum. User fees and memberships are expected to cover eventual operations and maintenance.

Wright explained the bidding process and the credentials of the team that will design and construct the facility. General contractor is J. L. Robinson. The Carbondale firm of White and Borgognoni is handling design of the bathhouse. Engineering is being planned by Asaturian and Eaton. The St. Louis-based firms of West Port Pools and Counsilman-Hunsaker, along with Midwest Pool Management (a subsidiary of West Port Pools), are consulting on design and operation.

The park is expected to be a state-of-the art community pool, I featuring a zero-depth entry area, a "Lazy River" (up to 600 feet), water slides, and a separate multi-lane competition pool. If current plans for the competition pool can be expanded from six to eight lanes, the facility may be able to attract highly sought competitive events. The final design is being negotiated as the design-build process continues.
