Polio Eradication Challenge!

As of 31 December 2009, Rotarians have raised approximately \$107 million for the \$200 Million Challenge.

The contributions will help Rotary raise \$200 million (by June 2012) to match \$355 million in challenge grants received from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. The resulting \$555 million will directly support immunization campaigns in developing countries, where polio continues to infect and paralyze children, robbing them of their futures and compounding the hardships faced by their families.

Since the PolioPlus program's inception in 1985, more than two billion children have received oral polio vaccine. But Rotary's work is not done: The disease has not yet been eradicated. — *from www.rotary.org*
