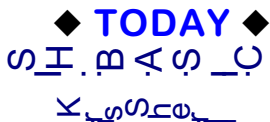

### Can You Name the Fourth?

Gustavus Loehr, Hiram Shorey, and Silvester Schiele ... who is the fourth person in this famous group?

Together, they are not a rock band ... not poker tournament finalists ... not a barbershop quartet.

These four men started something more than 100 years ago that has since spanned the globe and had significant social and humanitarian impact. At first, they met just to talk about their personal experiences, taking turns gathering in their respective offices. The famous fourth person sought to capture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth.

On 23 February 1905, these associates of Paul Harris met in Room 711 in Chicago's Unity Building, starting down the pathway to the world's first service club. Rotarians have preserved the famed location for many years; the Paul Harris 711 Club maintained the room as a shrine for visiting Rotarians. In 1989, when the Unity Building was scheduled to be demolished, the club carefully dismantled the office and salvaged the interior, including doors and radiators. In 1993, the RI Board of Directors set aside a permanent home for the restored Room 711 at RI World Headquarters in Evanston.
