MAYOR BRAD COLE

Former Rotarian, Carbondale Mayor **Brad Cole**, shared an update on the City of Carbondale. He recalled fondly his previous involvement as a club member during National Night Out in August.

He noted with some pleasure that the nation's economic recession has spared the city somewhat, hinting that tax revenues and other income has not lagged significantly.

The May 8 derecho left a trail of fallen trees and a lot of big bills behind. The official estimate is some 4,000 trees lost, with several million dollars of damage to property and public areas. In addition, there was major cost to the pick up of refuse from residential properties.

He reported that the City Council would consider that evening the question of continuing or not continuing funding for the day care program at the Eurma Hayes Center. He traced about five years' history of the matter, noting that the annual subsidy has been \$150,000 - 250,000.

In answers to questions, he reported the city's population is increasing and construction of new apartments has had a mixed history, driven to some extent by SIUC's decisions on housing.
