CUBA & ROTARY

President **Julia Wetstein**, Rotary Club of Carbondale, shared information about the club's efforts to develop a presence for Rotary International in Cuba by engaging Cuban medical professionals in Belize. District 6510's Belize Children's Program Inc. would benefit from the cooperative effort.

Currently, a carefully planned extension effort by Rotary International is intended to explore and develop the opportunity for Rotary clubs to be chartered in Cuba. The idea has been growing for 15 years; Fidel Castro disbanded all service clubs in Cuba in 1979.

One source of Cuban pride is health care. The island nation has more MDs per capita population than the USA. A video clip from the Cuban Ministry of Health underscored this status. A relevant factor is the Cuban ministry's medical outreach program.

Working with important consultants, Rotary International, the U.S. State Department, and other agencies and organizations, Julia and committee members from the RC-Carbondale have made progress in the last year. District 6510's Council of Governors provided grant support for visits to Washington, then to Cuba.

The eventual intent is to place Cuban orthopedic professionals in residence in Belize to manage local efforts. Perhaps, the cooperative effort will open doors for RI to return to Cuba in the future.
