RI's 101st Convention

Highlights of the Montreal Convention:

- ★ RI President (2009-2010) John Kenny presented closing remarks as the completed his year in office.
- ★ Kalyan Banerjee was officially elected as RI President (2011-12), presented his acceptance remarks.
- ★ Queen Noor and President Jo Luck of Heifer International praise RI for international good works and goodwill, both emphasizing the importance of shared visions and cooperation.
- ★ RI President Ray Klinginsmith previewed the 2010-11 Rotary Year, the next convention in New Orleans, and the significance of "cowboy logic" for Rotarians: taking pride in your work; talking less, saying more; doing what has to be done; and remembering that some things just aren't for sale. He urged clubs to be "Bigger, Better, and Bolder."
- ★ Bob Mazzuca, Chief Executive of the Boy Scouts of America, spoke of the shared history of RI and BSA, noting the similarities of the Four-Way Test and the Boy Scouts Oath and Law.

Falconry Today

PP **George Waring** educated club members about the origin/history, language, training, and types of falcons, hawks, and other birds of prey. Centuries ago, the use of birds of prey originated for food gathering, but also became a recreational activity for the wealthy.

Waring explained the lingo for different methods of obtaining birds as nestlings, young birds, or adult birds. He summarized the "manning" (taming) effort, then showed various items of equipment, such as the Jess (leather straps on the legs), leg bands, leash, block, lure, and tracking antenna.

He reported that falconry today is not just a sport. Applied falconry includes the use of birds of prey to avoid bird air strike hazards. Planes face bird strike problems at airports and during annual migrations, with thousands of incidents annually.

Among the species shown or mentioned were the Prairie Hawk (western US), Lanner falcon (Africa and southern Europe), Peregrine falcon (worldwide), American Kestrel (North America), Harris's Hawk (southern US and Latin America), and the Eurasian Eagle-Owl (released inside warehouses to prevent nesting of other birds).
