## YOUTH & FAMILIES

Detective **Brooke Hamill** and Officer **Randy Mathis** of the Carbondale Police Department shared a closer view of several programs focused on youth and families. Mathis noted eight departmental goals that shape the programs, then specific thanked the club for continuing involvement in National Night Out.

In turn, Mathis and Hamill described eight varying programs to serve community needs:

- ◆ Citizens Police Academy
- ◆ DARE - Drug Abuse Resistance Education
- ◆ Victim Impact Panel - diversion program
- ◆ GREAT - Gang Resistance Education and Training
- ◆ Personal Safety for Women
- ◆ Pumpkin Patrol
- ◆ SHOCAP - Serious Habitual Offender-Comprehensive Action Program
- ◆ Student Police Academy.

Both officers emphasized a particular intent in their work to remove a common perception with some citizens – often portrayed to youth – that the police and the community are opponents.
