## MORRIS LIBRARY

The club meeting was held at SIUC's Morris Library's American Heritage Room to view results of the multi-million dollar renovation, nearing completion. Most books are still in active storage at the McLafferty Road annex.

Dean **David Carlson** and Associate Dean **Susan Tulis** shared information about the ongoing renovation, started in 2005. A re-dedication was held in April 2009.

Carlson reported the building has been completely renovated with very few original elements remaining. To assist library users, floor plans have been totally revised for ease of use. The few elements that are virtually unchanged are some staircases, the Hall of Presidents and Chancellors (modernized), and a few structural elements. He noted that round pillars mark the older section of the renovated building and square pillars were used in the new sections. Floor plans are now quite similar; in the past, each floor had a different arrangement.

With continuing stringencies in state funding, holdings have been reviewed and restructured. For example, Morris Library has had as many as 20,000 journal series, now down to less than 2,000, with extensive use of digital access.
