The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

SECOND. High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.



What is Rotary?

Rotary International is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide to provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world.

History

This Rotary club was chartered in October 1988, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Carbondale. We were among the first Rotary clubs in District 6510 (Southern Illinois) to include women members.

This club's membership represents a cross-section of the businesses, institutions, and professions in our diverse community. In just a few years, we began to exert leadership in District 6510 and earned recognition for philanthropic support of The Rotary Foundation, for community and youth service, and for providing leaders at higher levels of Rotary.

A prominent member became District Governor less than a decade after our founding, with a second governor only a few years later. Numerous other members have distinguished the club through a broad range of district activities.

To spread the Rotary ideal, in 1997 we sponsored and mentored the Rotary Club of the Greater Carterville Area, which has become a very enthusiastic and contributing club.
