**Classification Talk** (3-4 minutes). The focus is your *classification* (profession or occupation), not your own personal or professional background.

**Rotary Insight** (3-4 minutes). Inform the club about some aspect of Rotary that we might not otherwise know.

**Getting to Know Ourselves** (3-4 minutes): The focus is your volunteer activities, unique hobbies, special skills beyond your profession, or other interesting activity or experience.
